MPP Yakabuski Appointed to three Ontario P.C. Task Forces

(Toronto) Renfrew-Nipissing-Pembroke MPP John Yakabuski will serve on three key Ontario P.C. Policy Task Forces that will develop a plan of action to be implemented if the Conservatives are elected to govern the Province in 2007.

Mr. Yakabuski is serving on the Task Forces for Agriculture and Rural Development, Energy, and Environment. Mr. Yakabuski and MPP Ernie Hardeman will share the lead responsibility for the Task Force on Agriculture and Rural Development.
