**What is this about?**

**On every litre of gasoline, drivers pay a tax of 14.7 cents to the provincial government.**

It all adds up to more than \$2.3 billion collected by the McGuinty government every year.

Yet, despite crumbling roads and bridges, municipalities in Renfrew-Nipissing-Pembroke are denied stable and predictable infrastructure funding.

This petition calls on the McGuinty Liberals to distribute gas tax revenues **fairly** to all municipalities across Ontario—not just to those with public transit systems, as it does today.
